



## How to take your measurements

To help ensure the closest fit for your special order dress, Lily & Iris needs to know your measurements.

We will use these measurements to help you decide the best size to order from the designer you have chosen.

Please keep in mind, Lily & Iris dresses are not made to these measurements, and you may need additional alterations once the dresses arrive.

We always recommend that measurements be taken by a professional, either a member of the Lily & Iris staff, or a trained seamstress or tailor.\* Many dress shops and alterationists offer this service free of charge.

A few tips about your measurements: always measure over undergarments and beneath outer clothing. Pull the cloth measuring tape snugly against your skin, always parallel to the ground, and make sure your fingers are not under the tape.

We need the following measurements:

- 1) Bust: measure the fullest part of your bust with the tape parallel to the ground
- 2) Waist: measure the natural waist. You can find this but standing straight and bending to the side. Where your body bends naturally is your waist.
- 3) Hips: with your feet together, measure at the widest point of your hips, including the fullest part of your bottom.
